All exams will be held in the Main Hall. Some students with specific access arrangements may sit their exams in rooms C219, C220 or W101. Rooms and seats will be clearly labelled on student's individual exam timetables.

Students should report to the hub courtyard 10 minutes before each exam is scheduled to start for their registration and exam line up. Access Arrangement rooms will be dismissed from this point.
